MAMSI Names Recipient of Sixth Annual Spirit of Service Award

A resident of Burtonsville, Md., Ms. Walters joined MAMSI Health Plans in 1996. When she is not volunteering, she is managing the administrative support staff for Clinical Care Coordination nurses in MAMSI’s Behavioral Health Department. “It’s very gratifying to work for a Company that rewards employees for working in the community,” says Ms. Walters.
